What needs to happen?

- Complexity must be abstracted into easy and usable solutions. More complexity = less usage

- Internet Service Providers needs to re-capture the reclining ARPU, if not QoE will suffer for all providers.
- Triple play monolithic services, needs to be supplemented/replaced by new services, micro services are the low hanging fruit.
